Enhancing Mental Health and Suicide Prevention Through Campus Planning Act

This bill requires the Department of Education to encourage institutions of higher education to develop and implement evidence-based comprehensive campus mental health and suicide prevention plans.

- **Jun 23, 2022:** Mr. Scott (VA) moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill, as amended.
- **Jun 23, 2022:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H5841-5842)
- **Jun 23, 2022:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 5407.
