#### Preventing Unjust Red Flag Laws Act of 2021

This bill prohibits the use of federal funds to implement or enforce red flag laws. The term *red flag laws* means a risk-based, temporary, and preemptive protective order that authorizes the removal of firearms without due process.

- **Nov 1, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
