Burn Pit Program to Review Operations and Management of ILER System Efficacy Act or the Burn Pit PROMISE Act

This bill requires the Government Accountability Office to study and report on the implementation and effectiveness of the Individual Longitudinal Exposure Record program of the Department of Defense and the Department of Veterans Affairs.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 25, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs.
- **Oct 15, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 15, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
