CBP Donations Acceptance Program Reauthorization Act

This bill extends through December 31, 2026, the authority of U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) to enter into an agreement with any entity to accept donations of real and personal property for certain activities at ports of entry. Further, the bill allows CBP to accept donations at leased land ports of entry.

- **Oct 25, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Border Security, Facilitation, and Operations.
- **Oct 22, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 22, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Homeland Security, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, and Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Oct 22, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Trade.
