### Summary (as of Oct 25, 2021)

#### **Smarter Pretrial Detention for Drug Charges Act of 2021**

This bill removes the presumption of pretrial detention for an individual who is charged with a federal drug offense for which the maximum term of imprisonment is 10 years or more.
