Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4) to amend the Voting Rights Act of 1965 to revise the criteria for determining which States and political subdivisions are subject to section 4 of the Act, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 3684) to authorize funds for Federal-aid highways, highway safety programs, and transit programs, and for other purposes; and providing for the adoption of the concurrent resolution (S. Con. Res. 14) setting forth the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal year 2022 and setting forth the appropriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2023 through 2031; and for other purposes.

Summary (as of Aug 24, 2021)

This resolution (1) sets forth the rule for consideration of H.R. 4 (establishing new criteria for the preclearance of, public notification of changes to, and judicial consideration of challenges to voting practices); (2) provides for the consideration of Senate amendments to H.R. 3684 (providing funding for infrastructure projects); and (3) provides for the adoption of S.Con.Res. 14 (establishing the congressional budget for FY2022, setting forth budgetary levels for FY2023-FY2031, and providing reconciliation instructions for legislation that increases the deficit).

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 24, 2021:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 117-115, by Mr. Neguse.
- **Aug 24, 2021:** Provides for consideration of H.R. 4, the Senate amendment to H.R. 3684, and S. Con. Res. 14. Rule makes in order one hour of debate on H.R. 4 and the Senate amendment to H.R. 3684 and allows for a motion to recommit for H.R. 4. S. Con. Res. 14 is hereby adopted.
- **Aug 24, 2021:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 31.
- **Aug 24, 2021:** Pursuant to the provisions of H. Res. 601, H. Res. 594 is laid on the table.
- **Aug 23, 2021:** Introduced in House
