Summary (as of Nov 17, 2021)

This bill expands Medicare coverage of vaccines to include any vaccine for adults that is recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Currently, Medicare covers vaccines for influenza, hepatitis B, pneumococcal disease, and COVID-19.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 18, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Nov 17, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 17, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Nov 17, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
