Helping Unleash Benefits and Services for Veterans Act of 2021 or the HUBS for Veterans Act of 2021

This bill establishes a grant program to assist the transition of military personnel to civilian life. It directs the Department of Labor to carry out a five-year program of grants to nonprofit organizations that assist the transition of the following persons from Armed Forces service to civilian life:

- members eligible for preseparation counseling,
- former members who are transitioning to civilian life, and
- spouses of such members or former members.

Funds must be used for a broad range of supportive programs, such as job recruitment training.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 6, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity.
- **Dec 20, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 20, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
