More Opportunities for Veterans to Exercise Act or the MOVE Act

This bill requires the General Services Administration to delegate authority to the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) for leasing space for preventive health fitness programs and counseling.

The bill also expands the definition of preventive health services (in relation to VA health care programs) to include (1) physical activity counseling, and (2) weight management services and physical activity programs.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 20, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jan 11, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **Jan 6, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 6, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.

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
