Marriage Equality for Disabled Adults Act

This bill eliminates certain marriage-related criteria for Social Security Disability Insurance benefits for Disabled Adult Children (DAC). It also expands access to Supplemental Security Income and Medicaid for married DAC recipients.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 14, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jan 13, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 13, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jan 13, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Social Security.
