This bill elevates the current position of the Director of the Indian Health Service within the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) to Assistant Secretary for Indian Health within HHS.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 20, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee for Indigenous Peoples of the United States.
- **Jan 14, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jan 13, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 13, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
