Combating Wildlife Trafficking Financing and Proceeds Study Act

This bill requires the Department of the Treasury and the Fish and Wildlife Service to jointly study the illicit financing of and other matters related to wildlife trafficking, including the national security implications and the use of online platforms to facilitate wildlife trafficking.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 26, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife.
- **Jan 25, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 25, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
