Driving Veterans Success Act

This bill requires that at least 10% of the funds under specified infrastructure programs are expended through veteran-owned small businesses.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 28, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 28, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Small Business, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
