Summary (as of Feb 1, 2022)

Regional Clean Energy Innovation Act

This bill requires the Department of Energy to establish an Office of Advanced Clean Energy Technologies to advance mid-stage and late-stage innovation, development, demonstration, and commercialization of clean energy technologies to further regional net-zero greenhouse gas emissions pathways.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 2, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **Feb 1, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 1, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
