Summary (as of Feb 9, 2022)

Protecting Parental Rights Act

This bill establishes a new federal criminal offense for administering a COVID-19 vaccine to a minor without the prior consent of a custodial parent or legal guardian of the minor. A violation is subject to a fine, a prison term of up to one year, or both.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 1, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **Feb 9, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 9, 2022:** Referred to the House Committee on the Judiciary.
