American Offshore Worker Fairness Act

This bill further restricts foreign crew members from working on vessels, rigs, and other structures engaged in offshore energy activities on the Outer Continental Shelf.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 24, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources.
- **Feb 16, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation.
- **Feb 15, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 15, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
