## Summary (as of Feb 18, 2022)

### Advancing Hydrogen Power Research and Development Act

This bill requires the Department of Energy and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) to report on barriers to the development, deployment, and use of hydrogen as a fuel source for residential, commercial, industrial, and electric power uses. Additionally, FERC must implement a pilot program for hydrogen blending projects in accordance with the Natural Gas Act.

## **Actions Timeline**

- **Feb 21, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **Feb 18, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 18, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
