Actions Timeline

- **Nov 1, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Antitrust, Commercial, and Administrative Law.
- **Mar 1, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation.
- **Feb 28, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 28, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
