### Summary (as of Mar 1, 2022)

#### **Powering America through Domestic Energy Act or the PADE Act**

This bill requires the President to prohibit the importation of crude oil and petroleum products from Russia. In addition, the bill requires the President to obtain congressional approval before (1) declaring a moratorium on the use of hydraulic fracturing, or (2) withdrawing federal land from oil and gas leasing under mineral leasing laws.

- **Mar 8, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources.
- **Mar 2, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **Mar 1, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 1, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, Energy and Commerce, and Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
