No Travel for Traffickers Act of 2022

This bill bars from the visa waiver program any country that allows individuals to obtain citizenship by making an investment in that country.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 1, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Immigration and Citizenship.
- **Mar 3, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 3, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
