## **National Commission on the COVID-19 Pandemic Act**

This bill temporarily establishes the National Commission on the COVID-19 Pandemic in the legislative branch to investigate the facts and circumstances regarding the emergence of, spread of, and response to COVID-19. The commission terminates 90 days after it submits a final report of its findings and recommendations.

## **Actions Timeline**

- **Mar 14, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 11, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 11, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Intelligence (Permanent Select), for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
