Garrett Lee Smith Memorial Reauthorization Act

This bill reauthorizes through FY2027 multiple suicide prevention programs and related activities with a particular focus on youth and young adults.

Specifically, the bill reauthorizes

- grants for statewide or tribal youth suicide prevention and early intervention strategies and for mental health and substance use disorder services for college students,
- a working group tasked with developing a plan to carry out a public education campaign concerning access to and reducing stigma associated with mental health services at institutions of higher education, and
- a suicide prevention resource center that provides training and other resources regarding suicide prevention among all ages.

- **Mar 28, 2022:** Referred to the House Committee on Energy and Commerce.
