Summary (as of Nov 17, 2022)

Improving Oversight of the Veterans Community Care Providers Act of 2022

This bill requires the Veterans Health Administration to carry out a plan to improve the methods by which the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) identifies health care providers that are not eligible to participate in the Veterans Community Care Program.

The VA must certify to Congress it has implemented the plan not later than 270 days after the enactment of this bill.

- **Nov 14, 2022:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 7277.
- **Nov 14, 2022:** At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
