Summary (as of Oct 21, 2021)

This resolution finds Stephen K. Bannon in contempt of Congress for failing to comply with a congressional subpoena. It also directs the Speaker of the House to (1) certify the related report from the Select Committee to Investigate the January 6th Attack on the United States Capitol to the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Columbia for criminal proceedings, and (2) take all other appropriate action to enforce the subpoena.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 21, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 21, 2021:** By direction of the Select Committee to Investigate the January 6th Attack on the United States Capitol, Mr. Thompson (MS) called up H.Res. 730 and asked for its immediate consideration.
- **Oct 21, 2021:** Considered under the provisions of rule H. Res. 727. (consideration: CR H5758-5769)
- **Oct 21, 2021:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 730.
- **Oct 21, 2021:** The previous question was ordered pursuant to the rule.
