Summary (as of Apr 7, 2022)

Energy Security and Independence Act of 2022

This bill addresses domestic industrial base and manufacturing capabilities for specified energy-efficiency and renewable energy systems and technologies (e.g., electric transportation systems), including by establishing a program to provide financial assistance for the construction of new facilities that manufacture components of specified energy-efficiency and renewable energy systems and technologies (or to retool, retrofit, or expand such facilities).

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 8, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **Apr 7, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 7, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Financial Services, and Education and Labor, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
