Revitalizing Small and Local Businesses Act

This bill establishes a competitive grant program, administered by the Economic Development Administration, for national nonprofit organizations to partner with local organizations to provide specialized technical assistance, capacity building, and related services that support small businesses and business district revitalization in low-income, rural, and minority communities.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 8, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **Apr 7, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 7, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
