Summary (as of Apr 7, 2022)

Replacing Essential Passports and Licenses After Certain Emergencies Act or the REPLACE Act

This bill requires the President to automatically waive fees to replace critical documents for individuals and households affected by major disasters for which assistance is provided under the Individuals and Households Program.

- **Apr 7, 2022:** Introduced in House
