Summary (as of Apr 14, 2022)

Plain Prescription Prices Act

This bill requires the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to issue a rule requiring direct-to-consumer television advertisements for prescription drugs that are covered by Medicare or Medicaid to include a textual statement of the drug's list price.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 15, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Apr 14, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 14, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
