### Summary (as of Apr 21, 2022)

#### Warrant for Metadata Act

This bill addresses the disclosure of customer electronic communications or records, including by requiring a governmental entity to obtain a warrant before requesting that a provider of electronic communication service or remote computing service disclose a customer's metadata.
