Summary (as of Apr 26, 2022)

Countering Limitless Overtaking of User Data Act or the CLOUD Act

This bill requires the Department of Commerce to report on data servicing operations owned by Chinese entities. The report must address, for example, whether these Chinese entities may be subsidized by China.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 27, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Consumer Protection and Commerce.
- **Apr 26, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 26, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
