Summary (as of Apr 26, 2022)

Economic Development Promotion and Resiliency Act

This bill modifies the Economic Development Administration's (EDA) public works and economic development programs. For example, the bill establishes grants (1) for predevelopment activities (e.g., community asset mapping); (2) for economic development capacity building; and (3) to support outdoor recreation, tourism, hospitality.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 27, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **Apr 26, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 26, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
