This bill permanently allows Medicare beneficiaries to receive telehealth services at renal dialysis facilities.

Actions Timeline

- **May 24, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **May 24, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **May 24, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
