Summary (as of May 31, 2022)

Ensuring Child Health Coverage Compensation in Divorce Act of 2022

This bill requires health insurance plans to permit custodial parents of children covered by the plan of a noncustodial parent, including a stepparent, to access such plan, including to submit payments and claims, without the approval of the noncustodial plan-holder parent.

Actions Timeline

- **May 31, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **May 31, 2022:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E566)
- **May 31, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, and Oversight and Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **May 31, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
