Summary (as of Jun 7, 2022)

National Education Security Training Act of 2022 or the NEST Act of 2022

This bill amends the Internal Revenue Code to allow a \$1,500 tax credit for veterans and retired law enforcement officers who are employed part-time by a local law enforcement agency to patrol one or more elementary or secondary schools or institutions of higher education.
