### Summary (as of Jun 14, 2022)

#### Repair Abuses of MSP Payments Act or the RAMP Act

This bill repeals the private right of action against insurance plans that do not provide appropriate primary payment in cases in which Medicare is a secondary payer.

### Actions Timeline
