Summary (as of Jun 15, 2022)

Tribal Energy Investment Act of 2022

This bill authorizes the Department of Energy to provide direct loans to Indian tribes and tribal energy development organizations for energy development. These direct loans shall be made through the Federal Financing Bank.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 16, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **Jun 15, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 15, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Science, Space, and Technology, and Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
