Summary (as of Jun 15, 2022)

Reducing Medically Unnecessary Delays in Care Act of 2022

This bill requires Medicare coverage decisions, including prior authorization requirements and adverse coverage decisions, to be based on written clinical criteria that is developed in consultation with physicians.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 15, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 15, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jun 15, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health
