### Summary (as of Jun 15, 2022)

#### Drought Relief through Innovative Projects Act of 2022 or the DRIP Act of 2022

This bill directs the Department of Agriculture to establish a competitive grant program to (1) remove nonnative plant species in riparian areas that contribute to drought conditions, (2) replace those nonnative plant species with native plant species, and (3) maintain and monitor riparian areas in which nonnative plant species have been removed and replaced.

- **Jun 30, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Biotechnology, Horticulture, and Research.
- **Jun 15, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 15, 2022:** Referred to the House Committee on Agriculture.
