Summary (as of Jun 15, 2022)

Fostering Opportunities for Resources and Education Spending through Timber Sales Act of 2022 or the FORESTS Act of 2022

This bill directs the Department of Agriculture to designate an area of each national forest for production of material to provide revenue for payments under the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 30, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Jun 15, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 15, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
