Water Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act Amendments of 2022

This bill expands and modifies the Water Infrastructure and Innovation Act (WIFIA) loan program by, for example, expanding eligibility to state water storage projects, transferred works, and certain nonfederally owned projects. WIFIA provides credit assistance through secured or direct loans for water infrastructure projects.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 17, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Jun 16, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 16, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
