Summary (as of Jun 17, 2022)

Lone Star Reimbursement Act

This bill requires the Department of Defense to provide approximately \$1.43 billion to the state of Texas as reimbursement for the costs of Operation Lone Star incurred in FY2021 and FY2022.

(Operation Lone Star is a border security operation initiated and carried out by the state of Texas.)

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 1, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Immigration and Citizenship.
- **Jun 17, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 17, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
