Summary (as of Nov 18, 2021)

This resolution supports (1) reducing congestion at high-volume coastal ports and expanding options for importing and exporting goods, and (2) the potential for more international container ship traffic through the Saint Lawrence Seaway and Great Lakes ports.

The resolution also expresses support for Great Lakes and inland waterway ports and their current and future role in international trade commerce.
