Summary (as of Jun 28, 2022)

No Patient Left Alone Act of 2022

This bill requires hospitals, as a condition of Medicare participation, to have certain written policies and procedures that provide for patient visitation rights and to inform patients of such rights, including any applicable restrictions.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 28, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 28, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jun 28, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
