Federal Interior Land Media Act or the FILM Act

This bill rewrites provisions for commercial filming activities or similar projects in National Park System units and on other federal lands.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 3, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Jul 14, 2022:** Subcommittee Hearings Held.
- **Jul 12, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands.
- **Jul 1, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 1, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
