Summary (as of Jul 7, 2022)

U.S.-Albania Cooperation Act

This bill requires the Department of Defense and the Department of State to report on the viability of military infrastructure in two port cities in Albania as locations for cooperative security activities, including NATO (North Atlantic Treaty Organization) activities and exercises. The report must also include a description of opportunities and cost estimates for the United States to support training and equipment for Albania's military forces.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 7, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 7, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jul 7, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Europe, Energy, the Environment and Cyber.

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
