Summary (as of Jul 18, 2022)

Coast Guard Intelligence Operations Improvement Act of 2022

This bill authorizes the Coast Guard, with limitations, to expend funds appropriated for intelligence and counterintelligence activities without regard to other expenditure-related law or regulation, if it is spent on emergency, confidential, or extraordinary activities and the Coast Guard notifies the congressional intelligence committees. This authorization applies for three years after enactment.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 19, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation.
- **Jul 18, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 18, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Intelligence (Permanent Select), for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
