Summary (as of Jul 21, 2022)

Protecting and Preserving Social Security Act

This bill revises methods for calculating various aspects of Social Security benefits, eliminates the cap on compensation subject to Social Security taxes, and extends eligibility for Social Security benefits during the month of a beneficiary's death.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 21, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 21, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, and Education and Labor, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jul 21, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Social Security.
