Office of Disaster Recovery Act

This bill directs the Department of Commerce to establish an Office of Disaster Recovery.

The office must direct and implement the Economic Development Administration's post-disaster economic recovery responsibilities and economic recovery support function activities as directed under the National Disaster Recovery Framework.

Additionally, the bill increases the federal share for a project for economic recovery in response to a major disaster or emergency declared under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 28, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **Jul 27, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 27, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
