Summary (as of Jul 29, 2022)

Exchange Regulatory Improvement Act of 2022

This bill revises the definition of *facility* for purposes of regulation under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Specifically, the bill provides that a facility does not include any service that can legally be offered by a person or entity that is not a registered exchange.
