## Advanced Border Coordination Act of 2022

This bill requires the Department of Homeland Security to establish at least two Joint Operations Centers along the U.S.-Mexico border. The centers shall provide centralized operations hubs for (1) coordinating operations between federal, state, local, and tribal agencies as needed; and (2) coordinating and supporting border operations, including detecting criminal activity, such as activity related to transnational criminal organizations and illegal border crossings.

### **Actions Timeline**

- **Nov 1, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Immigration and Citizenship.
- **Aug 3, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Border Security, Facilitation, and Operations.
- **Aug 3, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Oversight, Management, and Accountability.
- **Aug 2, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Aug 2, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, and Homeland Security, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
